
Term 1 2024

BB Uniform

Our BB Company is a 'contemporary uniform' Company, meaning that we use the more modern, relaxed uniform option for boys. We believe that uniform should not be a barrier to participation but equally that uniform helps build a sense of connection and encourages boys to take responsibility for their preparation and presentation (contributing to a sense of self-respect).

Each Parade night, evenings begin with an inspection with points accumulated for Best Squad and Best Boy awards at the end of the year. The basic uniform includes the blue polo shirt and cap. A small number of additional points are awarded for other uniform items. For more detail, please see the list below:

Anchors/Juniors Uniform

- Navy blue polo shirt (with logo)
- Navy blue cap (with logo)
- Armband/badges worn on the right arm
- Navy blue shorts OR slacks
- Navy blue socks (BB socks are available)
- Black shoes or sandshoes

Seniors Uniform

- Navy blue polo shirt (with logo)
- Navy blue cap (with logo)
- Armband/badges worn on the right arm (regular badges)
- Navy blue slacks OR shorts
- BB black belt
- Navy blue socks (BB socks are available)
- Black shoes (polishable) with a change of sneakers preferred for activities
